SB 474 was signed in to law by Governor Brown on October 9, 2011. The law restricts the inclusion of Type 1 indemnity provisions in construction contracts for commercial projects and for any contracts with public entities. In short, Type 1 indemnity provisions will not allow the transfer of indemnity for a party's **active** negligence.
